

Privacy statement Vereniging Directe Leden

General

Your privacy is of the utmost importance to the Vereniging Directe Leden (VDL) (*translation: Direct Members Association*). When we process your data, we do so in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (Algemene Verordening Gegevensbescherming (AVG)), which protects your personal data.

VDL is a member of the KNSB. The association is anchored in the statutes of the KNSB. We apply the rules that the KNSB uses, because the administration of the VDL is conducted directly in the federation administration. The KNSB (address Mississippiplein 153, 3565 CE Utrecht) is responsible for the data processing. Below is the privacy statement of the KNSB dated July 1, 2024. Which personal data are processed?

If you are a member of an association that is a member of the KNSB, your personal data will be included in the KNSB's administration. This personal data includes: name, gender, home address with postcode and place of residence, date of birth, e-mail address, nationality, telephone number and date of start of membership as well as test and competition results. In addition, we process the cookie data for which consent has been granted when you visit our website.

For what purposes does the KNSB use your data?

The membership data is used for the purpose of carrying out the membership, including:

- determining and collecting the annual membership fee of your association
- registering data for products related to the membership, such as insurance.

The KNSB can also use your data to achieve its statutory objective of promoting skating and skating in the Netherlands. This includes, for example:

- maintaining and publishing test and competition results;
- developing, substantiating and evaluating the KNSB policy,
- generating a profile for sport-related research purposes and grant and/or sponsorship proposals,
- provision of information as an extension of KNSB activities, (if and to the extent necessary in cooperation with third parties).

For the rest, we process personal data in the context of an internship/application procedure and cookie data for the generation of statistics concerning the use of our website and/or to analyse and/or improve our website.

Legal basis of the processing of your data

According to the legislation, the KNSB may only process personal data if one of the legal bases applies. The KNSB uses the following legal grounds for the processing of personal data:

- in the context of the conclusion and/or execution of an agreement;
- to comply with the law (including accounting processing, tax obligations and obligations under court orders or other mandatory laws and regulations);
- in connection with the legitimate interests of the KNSB, whereby the KNSB ensures that the impact on your privacy is as limited as possible. For example, personal data is processed in connection with:
 - the management of member data, the performance of membership, or support thereof;
 - processing and publishing test and competition results of tests (such as aptitude) and competitions in which you have participated;
 - the creation of studies, models and statistics;
 - integrity reports, whether or not via the Case Management System for Sport (and any resulting disciplinary and dispute procedure);
 - implementation of the complaints procedure;

- maintaining and improving the website;
- a consent given by the data subject to the processing of his or her personal data (explicitly or via cookies on our website).

Responsible for the processing of personal data

The KNSB is responsible for the (sub)processing of your personal data. This means that the KNSB carefully determines the purposes and means of the processing and that it is responsible for compliance with the legal requirements. In the event that your data is shared with third parties (service providers), a processing agreement will always be concluded to protect your data.

To whom is your data disclosed?

The KNSB provides your data to NOC*NSF in the context of the central database of the 'Knowledge and Information System for Sport' (KISS) of NOC*NSF. In this context, the KNSB provides the following personal data every year: postal code, date of birth, gender and the start date of membership of the KNSB. Your name will not be used.

NOC*NSF uses this data for:

- a) the annual determination of the exact number of members in order to determine the number of votes to be cast by the KNSB in the general meeting of NOC*NSF;
- b) substantiating and evaluating policy and strategy in the field of sports participation issues on the basis of statistical data.

With the exception of the above-mentioned provision to NOC*NSF, the KNSB will not provide your personal data to third parties without your permission, unless:

- the KNSB is obliged to do so on the basis of the law or a court decision
- it is necessary for the execution of an agreement between you and the KNSB (such as the license agreement)
- you have given your specific consent to do so.

Exchange of personal data

The KNSB may exchange your (personal) data within the various departments of the KNSB, or with the various officials in the Netherlands and abroad. The KNSB ensures that the European standards of data protection are applied to personal data within its departments. However, the KNSB is not liable if it has to pass on personal data to authorities, in accordance with applicable legal obligations.

The purpose of processing your personal data may involve us sharing personal data with other organisations. Examples are the international federations and NOC*NSF. Insofar as there is no explicit consent or legal obligation, this exchange of data will only take place on the basis of the execution of the agreement between you and the KNSB or if the KNSB has a legitimate interest in doing so. An example of this is if it is necessary to inform the organiser of a competition in which you are participating.

The KNSB will not sell, rent, distribute or otherwise make your personal data commercially available to third parties, except as described in this privacy statement or unless with your prior consent.

Retention of personal data

The KNSB does not store personal data any longer than is necessary to achieve the purposes for which the data are processed, and in any case for as long as specific laws and regulations require.

Your privacy rights

You have the right to access your personal data, the right to request correction, restriction or deletion of your personal data and you can also request the transfer of your data. Furthermore, you can object (in specific cases) to the use of your data.

If the processing of your data is based on consent, you can withdraw it at any time by sending an

email to: info@knsb.nl. From that moment on, your personal data will no longer be processed. Even if you do not (or no longer) wish to receive information from the KNSB, you can send an e-mail to info@knsb.nl stating 'blocking'. The relevant change(s) will be implemented as soon as possible. You also have the right to file a complaint about the use of your data with the Dutch Data Protection Authority.

Security

We have taken appropriate (physical, technical and organisational) measures to protect your personal data for which we are responsible. In the event of a data breach, this will be reported to the data subject(s) as soon as possible.

Alterations

The KNSB may amend this privacy statement from time to time. We will publish the modified version on KNSB.nl and inform you through our newsletters.
